Biography

John Beresford

From 1940 to 1947 he served as Chairman (President) of the Board of Education. At the June 17, 1947 meeting a motion was "moved that a befitting testimonial, in recognition of Mr. Beresfords' 21 years of service to the school and the district, be prepared, and made part of these minutes and that a copy thereof be presented to Mr. Bereford." The copy is not to be found in the minutes.

On November 5, 1925 Mr. Beresford was one of the first District 30 trustees appointed to the newly formed Central High School District.² He served fifteen years as Vice President (1929 to 1938 & 1940 to 1947) and two years as President (1938-39 & 1939-40 school years).



She served on the District 30 Board from 1958 to 1991 She was president of District 30 for seven terms. They included 1963-64, 1964-65, 1970-71, 1980-81, 1981-82, 1984-85 and 1985-86.

She served on the High School Board of Education for 29 years – from 1962 to 1991. She was president on four separate occasions – 1965-66, 1974-75, 1983-84 and 1986-87.
