BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBERS School District Thirty

“A general inventory of records of New York State government published in 1900 (American Historical Association Annual Report, 1900) states that there were at that time in the office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction 135 volumes of school commissioner’s abstracts of school district trustees’ reports. These reports would have dated from 1865 on, since the elective office of school commissioner (predecessor to the district superintendents, 1912 +) was established in that year. Unfortunately these abstracts, which may have given trustees’ names, were totally destroyed in the Capital fire of March 29, 1911. Names of school district trustees were never published in any State government document.”¹

“In Archives series A3046 Abstracts of School Districts’ Reports 1905-1952 (489 Volumes) names of trustees are cited. These reports must be used in Albany since they are not available on microfilm.”²

Of the three elementary districts in Valley Stream, District 30 is the only one with a complete list of Board of Education Trustees. This is due to the fact that this district was the last to be formed on the elementary level. The only other district with a complete list of trustees is the Valley Stream Central High School District, which is composed of elementary trustees.

A motion passed at the Districts first meeting to have three trustees lead the district.³ At the second meeting of Common School District 30 (June 18, 1923) the

residents of the district voted to change to a Union Free School District.⁴ They also decided that the new district would be lead by five trustees.
