All that certain plot, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the incorporated Village of Valley Stream, Town of Hempstead, County of Nassau and State of New York bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at the point where the northerly line of the land of George Linder intersects the easterly line of Shaw Avenue; thence running South 62 degrees 48 minutes 12 seconds East along said land of Linder, 496.03 feet; thence running North 42 degrees 26 minutes 17 seconds East, 440 feet; thence running North 48 degrees 29 minutes 39 seconds West, 637.35 feet, to said easterly line of Shaw Avenue; thence running South 25 degrees 36 minutes West along said easterly line of Shaw Avenue, 582.10 feet, to the point of beginning;

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of Union Free School District No. 30 of the Town of Hempstead, Nassau County, New York, shall be authorized to appropriate not to exceed \$30,000.00 of the proceeds of sale of \$925,000.00 "School Building (Serial) Bonds, 1949" of said School District, dated July 1, 1949, issued to construct and equip an elementary school building now completed, and expend the same for the acquisition, in whole or in part, of a new school site for the School District as may be designated and authorized by the voters of such school District in compliance with the Education Law?

Proposition No. 2 Purchase Forest Road School Site

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to-wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of Union Free School District No. 30 of the Town of Hempstead, Nassau County, New York, is hereby authorized to purchase the land, hereinafter described, as a new school site for such School District, and, to expend therefore in addition to the \$30,000.00, which sum of \$16,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary,...

- b) to construct an addition to the Shaw Avenue School building, in said School District, including furnishing, equipment, machinery and apparatus for such addition, at an estimated maximum cost of \$200,000.00

and, such sum of \$827,500.00 being the aggregate of the aforesaid amounts, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said School District and collected in annual installments as provided by section 416 of the Education Law, and, in anticipation of such tax, obligations of said School District shall be issued.
